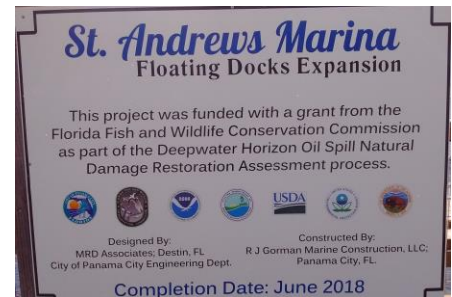
## A Motor

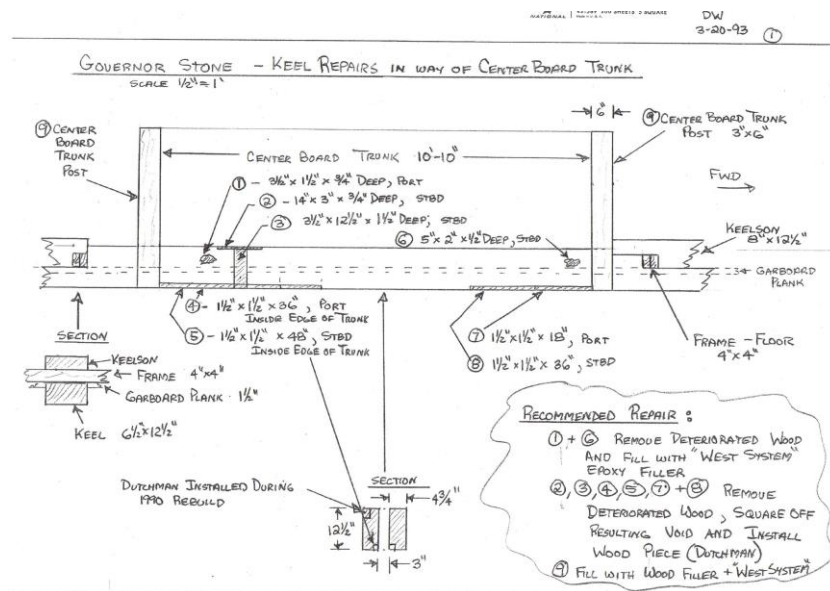
